




BOTA - UKBOTA - Bunkers On The Air

- Approx 2000 in the UK





Islands On The Air






- "encouraging operations from island locations"



For further information/pictures, please see my qrz.com page... Here are a few things to know before trying to attack Loudoun County HP: 1. The summit is near a gated area and accessible by foot, but there are a TON of power lines and generators in the area. Be ready to use every noise blanker and reducer you can find on your rig. Doug (W1DMH) also verified he had a lot of QRM on his trip as well. My only contact was EI9GLB from Ireland, and he has an plethora of awesome antennas at his disposal. Thank goodness that even if you don't get the points for 1 QSO, it still counts as an activation. Phew! 2. Police presence is notably high in the area patrolling, but friendly. 3. The area is fairly remote, so I stopped in Purcellville for essentials. 4. If one left early enough, this may be coupled with another mountain in the afternoon, but of course, I would not suggest it because it took me more than an hour just to get one contact here because of the QRM. It's a frustrating place to be! 5. Cell service with AT&T was good on this trip. I was able to easily spot myself via SOTA Goat.
